



Website Terms and Conditions of Use (T&Cs) Pursuant to Law No. 2013-450 on the Protection of Personal Data

Article 1: Purpose

Specific Provisions under Law No. 2013-450 on Personal Data Protection

Article 10: Collection and Processing of Personal Data

The Publisher collects and processes users' personal data for the following purposes:
